Abstract

The Edward Comstock Corwin Furniture Research Notes is a small collection that currently includes only photocopies of Corwin's handwritten research notes on the history of the furniture industry in Grand Rapids, Michigan. These notes include data points for Widdicomb Furniture Company, John Widdicomb Company, and the Widdicomb Mantel Company history. The source of the information is unknown. Additional holdings on Edward & Benn Comstock exist in the unprocessed collections, which will eventually be added here as part of an expanded Corwin Family Collection.
