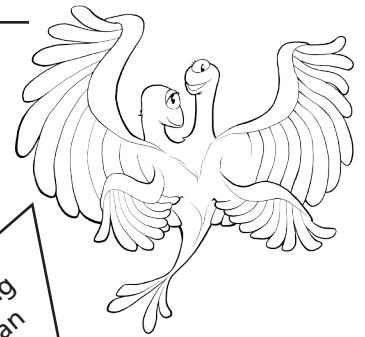
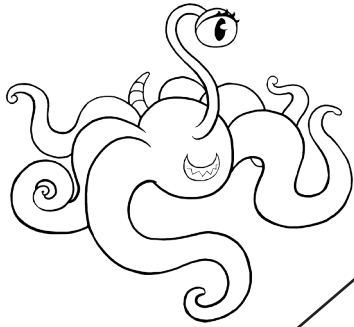


TODDLER SUMMER READING GAME

Pretend to be your favorite animal. What sound does it make?

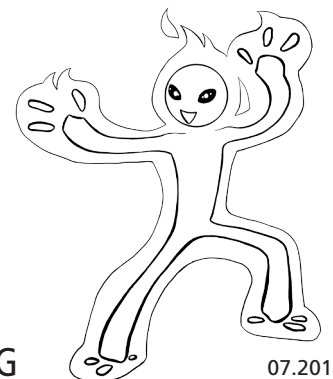
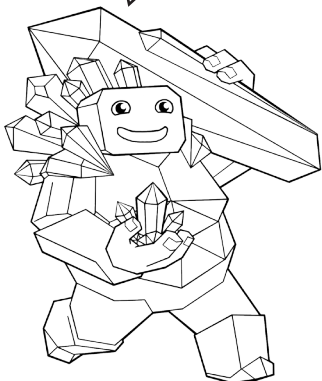
Count the stairs that you walk up throughout the day
